

Announcement on the resumption of Tourist Visa

The Myanmar Embassy will resume its services to issue “tourist visa” with effect from 1st August 2022. Tourist visa applicants must provide a certificate for full COVID-19 vaccination, a valid passport with at least 6-month validity and some blank pages and two recently taken colour photographs (please see details about the photograph from the link mentioned below).

Upon arrival to Myanmar, travellers must present the following documents at the respective airport health authorities:

- The necessary health documents in accordance with the latest Public Health Requirements regarding the control of COVID-19 issued by the Ministry of Health of Myanmar.
- The Inbound Travel Accident Insurance Policy with COVID-19 coverage purchased from Myanma Insurance. (The insurance can be purchased from the Myanma Insurance Office, No (627/635), Merchant Street, Yangon, Myanmar or online via : <https://www.mminsurace.gov.mm/%20inbound-travel-accident-insurance/> and detailed information can be obtained at the Myanma Insurance’s website).

Legal actions will be taken against those who violate or contravene any provision of the existing laws, rules and regulations of the Republic of the Union of Myanmar.
